The Second Conference of the International Society for the Social Sciences of Sport will take place from Friday, September 24, 2010 to Monday, September 27, 2010 at Josef Pilsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw in Poland.

The Second Conference of the International Society for the Social Sciences of Sport is organized by the ISSSS, the Ministry of Sport and Tourism and Josef Pilsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw on the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the University which takes place during 2009/2010 academic year, as well as by the Marshal Office of the Mazowieckie Voivodeship.

The Second International Society for the Social Sciences of Sport Conference is under the patronage of the Rector of the University of Physical Education in Warsaw, the Marshal of the Mazowieckie Voivodeship and the Polish Parliament's Senate Commission of Physical Culture and Sport.

The 2010 Conference will be hosted by Josef Pilsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw. Prof. Dr. Jerzy Kosiewicz will act as the Chair of the Organizing Committee and the Chair of the Scientific Committee. ## Abstracts

The ISSSS invites the submission of abstracts to be considered for presentation at the 1<sup>st</sup> annual 2010 ISSSS meeting.

Abstracts are welcome on any area of social sciences of sport. In addition to abstracts for papers, proposals for round table and panel discussions, including a tentative list of participants, are also welcome and should follow the same format as paper abstracts. Graduate students and emerging scholars are encouraged to submit their works in progress.

Abstracts should be 300-500 words long and must be received **by 25 August, 2010**. The preferred mode of submission is by e-mail. Please send the abstract as an attachment, preferably in Word. Contributors who do not have access to e-mail are free to send a hard copy instead.

**Attention:** Please submit the texts of abstracts and papers to the addresses which are given below (at the bottom of the INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS OF PAPERS section).

## Instructions for Submission of Abstracts

Please read these instructions carefully before preparing your abstract:

- Each presenting author is permitted to submit a maximum of two abstracts in the capacity of main author.
- Figures and tables are not acceptable.
- The abstract should be written in English. The title should be concise and descriptive of the work to be reported. Do not use any subtitles. Use Times New Roman font (font size 12) to write the text.
- The person submitting the abstract should appear as the first author and will be expected to present the work if it is accepted.
- The abstract should give - especially in empirical researches - the objectives of the study, the approach and the methods used, the results obtained, and the conclusions reached.
- Deadline for abstract submission is **25 August 2010**.



- The organizers reserve the right to change the mode of paper presentation and to choose a suitable session for the abstract. A blind review system will be used when evaluating the abstracts. Notice of acceptance will be e-mailed to the submitting authors till **31 August 2010**.
- Submitting authors must register as conference delegates and pay the registration fee. Abstracts without paid registration fees will not be published in the abstract book.
- Abstracts which have not been prepared according to these instructions will not be published in the abstract book.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS OF PAPERS**

### **Please strictly adhere to this editorial instruction.**

Before the proper text provide the following information in a successive order (Times New Roman font 10 pts, spacing before and after: 0 pts):

- The surname and forename of the author, full affiliation.
- The title of the paper should be concise and descriptive of the work to be reported.
- The abstract should contain about 200-300 words. Do not use any subtitles.
- Keywords from 3 to 5.

The proper text may be homogenous or it may be divided into an introduction, subsections, and a conclusion.

1. Pagination: the bottom of the page, external alignment.
2. The length of the article should not exceed 10 pages of typescript (including bibliography).
3. Text editor: MS Word (doc, docx).
4. Font – Times New Roman, 11 pts; Interline – 1,15;
5. Footnotes that explain or supplement a particular place in a text ought to be placed at the bottom of the page. Numbering must respect the rule of consecutiveness throughout the text – Times New Roman, 10pts.
6. Paragraph settings:
  - indentation: 1,25 cm,
  - spacing before and spacing after: 6 pts.
7. Margins: left – 2,5 cm, right – 2,5 cm, bottom – 2,5 cm, top – 2,5 cm
8. Text has to be aligned; one should not use a word division option, page division, heading and imprint.
9. In text referencing you should use the APA style Referencing System. Bibliography should be placed at the end of the article and the names of the main authors should be listed in an alphabetical order. References inside the text should be arranged according to the following pattern: (Kowalski 2001, pp. 23-25), (Kowalski 2003a, 2003b) etc.  
Please follow APA style rules for bibliographic citation. Use Font – Times New Roman, 10 pts; Interline – 1.0, spacing before and spacing after: 6 pts. In order to enhance reference linking prepare the references according to these standards:

**Format:** Author. (Year of publication). *Book title*. Place of publication: Publisher.

**Format:** Author1, Author2 & Author3. (Year of publication). *Book title*. Place of publication: Publisher.

**c. Book chapter or article in an edited book**

**Format:** Author(s) of chapter. (Year of publication). Chapter title. In Editors of the book (Eds.), *Book title* (Chapter page range). Place of publication: Publisher.

**Example:** Roll, W.P. (1976). ESP and memory. In J.M.O. Wheatley & H.L. Edge (Eds.), *Philosophical dimensions of parapsychology* (pp. 154-184). Springfield, IL: American Psychiatric Press.

**d. Proceedings from a conference**

**Format:** Author(s). (Year of publication). Title. In Conference name, Date (Page range). Place of publication: Publisher.

**Example:** Field, G. (2001). Rethinking reference rethought. In Revelling in Reference: Reference and Information Services Section Symposium, 12-14 October 2001 (pp. 59-64). Melbourne, Victoria, Australia: Australian Library and Information Association.

**e. ebook**

**Format:** Author(s). (Year of publication). *Title*. Publisher. Retrieving date, http address. DOI.

**Example:** Johnson, A. (2000). *Abstract Computing Machines*. Springer Berlin Heidelberg. Retrieved March 30, 2006, from SpringerLink <http://springerlink.com/content/w25154>. DOI: 10.1007/b138965.

**f. Thesis**

**Format:** Author(s). (Year of publication). *Title*. Information, Place of publication.

**Example:** Begg, M. M. (2001). *Dairy farm women in the Waikato 1946-1996: Fifty years of social and structural change*. Unpublished doctoral dissertation, University of Waikato, Hamilton, New Zealand.

**g. Report**

**Format:** Author(s). (Year of publication). *Title*. Place of publication: Publisher. (Report number)

**Example:** Osgood, D. W., & Wilson, J. K. (1990). *Covariation of adolescent health problems*. Lincoln: University of Nebraska. (NTIS No. PB 91-154 377/AS)

**h. Government publication**

**Format:** Institution name. (Year of publication). *Title*. Place of publication: Publisher.

**Example:** Ministerial Council on Drug Strategy. (1997). *The national drug strategy: Mapping the future*. Canberra: Australian Government Publishing Service.



## **B. Article**

### **a. Journal Article (one author)**

**Format:** Author. (Year of publication). Article title. *Journal Title*. Volume (issue), range of pages. DOI.

**Example:** Nikora, V. (2006). Hydrodynamics of aquatic ecosystems: spatial-averaging perspective. *Acta Geophysica*, 55(1), 3-10. DOI: 10.2478/s11600-006-0043-6.

### **b. Journal Article (two or more authors)**

**Format:** Author1, Author2 & Author3. (Year of publication). Article title. *Journal Title*. Volume (issue), range of pages. DOI.

**Example:** Cudak, M. & Karcz J. (2006). Momentum transfer in an agitated vessel with off-centred impellers. *Chem. Pap.* 60(5), 375-380. DOI: 10.2478/s11696-006-0068-y.

### **c. Journal article from an online database**

**Format:** Author(s). (Year of publication). Article title [Electronic version]. *Journal Title*. Volume (issue), range of pages. Retrieved date of access, from name of database. DOI.

**Example:** Czajgucki Z., Zimecki M. & Andruszkiewicz R. (2006, December). The immunoregulatory effects of edeine analogues in mice [Abstract]. *Cell. Mol. Biol. Lett.* 12(3), 149-161. ### **d. Newspaper article (no author)**

**Format:** Article title. (Publication date). *Journal Title*. page.

**Example:** Amazing Amazon region. (1989, January 12). *New York Times*, p. D11.

### **e. Encyclopedia article**

**Format:** Author. (Year of publication). Article title. In *Encyclopedia title* (volume number, pages). Place of publication: Encyclopedia name.

**Example:** Bergmann, P. G. (1993). Relativity. In *The new encyclopedia Britannica* (Vol. 26, pp. 501-508). Chicago: Encyclopedia Britannica.

## **C. Other formats**

### **a. Web page**

**Format:** Author/Sponsor. (last update or copyright date). *Title*. Retrieved date of access, from URL.

**Example:** Walker, J. (1996, August). *APA-style citations of electronic resources*. Retrieved November 21, 2001, from <http://www.cas.usf.edu/english/walker/apa.html>

### **b. Lecture note**

**Format:** Author(s). (Date of presentation). *Lecture title*. Lecture notes distributed in the unit, at the name of the teaching organisation, the location.

**d. Standard**

**Format:** Issue body. (Year). Standard name. Standard number. The location.

**Example:** Standards Association of Australia. (1997). Australian standard: Pressure equipment manufacture. AS4458-1997. North Sydney.

**e. Video**

**Format:** Producer, P. P. (Producer), & Director, D.D. (Director). (Date of publication). Title of motion picture [Motion picture]. Country of origin: Studio or distributor.

**Example:** Zhang, Y. (Producer/Director). (2000). Not one less [Motion Picture]. China: Columbia Pictures Industries, Inc.

**f. Audio recording**

**Format:** Songwriter, W. W. (Date of copyright). Title of song [Recorded by artist if different from song writer]. On Title of album [Medium of recording]. Location: Label. (Recording date if different from copyright date).

There are cheap and comfortable apartments in Building "F". Each apartment consists of a single and twin room including kitchen and bathroom.

The charge for twenty-four hour accommodation in guest rooms amounts to:

- single room - 80 PLN (about 20 EUR)
- twin room - 120 PLN (about 30 EUR per person)
- Apartment (2+1) - 200 PLN (about 50 EUR)
- Apartment (3+1) - 300 PLN (about 75 EUR)

According to the Directive No. 2/2008 issued by the Chancellor of Josef Pilsudski University of Physical Education the charge for a stay is paid by cash during checking in at the reception desk.

1. ATTENTION! Check-in time is 2 pm and check-out time is 10 am on the next day.
2. ATTENTION! We strongly recommend that every participant provides us with the original receipt of payment of the conference fee. As soon as we receive it, we will be able to issue an invoice to every person interested in receiving it.

### **Female Hall of Residence**

We are able to accommodate 70 people (both males and females) in total. According to Directive No. 9 issued by the Chancellor of Josef Pilsudski University of Physical Education the charges per room in Female Hall of Residence are listed as follows:

- There are only triple rooms. The fee for a room is 90 PLN (about 13.5 EURO).
- A fee for one person amounts 30 PLN (about 4.5 EUR). The low price ensues from the fact that the standard of the rooms is not very high.

ATTENTION! Every person who is interested in receiving an invoice ought to report to the Bursary (which is situated in the Management Office Building) in room 26. It opens from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. You should provide the original receipt of payment and a properly filled official form. Official forms are available at the reception desk.



## Transportation in the city

**Buses and trams** are the safest and the cheapest means of transport in big cities in Poland. You can use most of the lines between 5 am and 11 pm on working days.

The bus and tram tickets can be bought at newsagents' ("kiosk"-s), ticket machines located at stops or you can buy them directly from drivers. In Warsaw a single fare is 2,80 PLN. There is a possibility of buying a 24h ticket- 9,00 PLN, 3-day ticket- 16,00 PLN or a weekly city ticket- 32,00 PLN.

The **metro** (Warsaw Underground) operates between 5 am and 2.30 pm, and the trains run every 5 minutes during peak hours, and every 8 minutes outside peak hours. In order to get to Hotel Ibis, get off at 'Dworzec Gdański' station. The University is located at 'Stare Bielany' Station.

**Taxis** are available all day long. They charge lower fares between 8 am and 10 pm. and higher fares between 10 pm and 8 am Warsaw Frederic Chopin recommends three taxi corporations: 1) Merc Taxi +48226777777; 2) MPT Radio Taxi +4819191; 3) Sawa Taxi +48226444444.

*Taxi fare from the airport should be approx. 60 PLN. Be careful and if you do not want to risk being overcharged, take a radio taxi.*

### Public transport from the airport **Warsaw Frederic Chopin Airport**

You can also reach the city centre by bus number 188 which will take you to metro 'Politechnika; station. It runs from 4.43 am to 11.13 pm.

If you arrive at the Airport at night, it is possible to take bus number N32 which will take you to 'Warszawa-Centralna' railway station. It runs from 11.09 pm to 4.39 am.
